Hot Lunch On Tuesday and Thursday & Pizza Lunches: We are unable to provide utensils for students. All students should have a set of utensils from home on those days. Please be sure to check the schedule, so you know what days you have ordered.

Seasonal Weather: Please dress for the changing weather conditions. All students should have a pair of indoor and outdoor shoes.

Food & Snacks: This is a friendly reminder that parents are not permitted to send in treats/candies/food/loot bags at any time - including special times or holidays (Ex. Birthdays, Halloween, Valentines Day etc).

Late Arrivals and Early Pick-Ups: Late arrivals and early pick-ups are extremely disruptive to the routine of students, staff and the class in general. Parents are asked to ensure their children arrive at school on time and ready to learn. Parents are also asked to refrain from early pick-ups unless there is a legitimate reason (drs appointment, family emergency etc.). Please avoid pick-ups between 2:00-2:30pm as much as possible as the end of the day is a busy time for all.

Parking Lot Safety: As the weather changes, more and more cars will use the parking lot and express drop off lane. This is a friendly reminder to parents that student safety is our first priority. Parents are asked to reduce their speed in the parking lot and allow children and families to the right of way. Parents are also asked to wait until 8:00am to leave the parking lot once parked. Parents who use the express drop off lane are asked to have their kids ready to hop out. Parents should not be exiting their cars to get kids ready in the drop off lane. To help the system flow safely, parents are asked to advance so that 4 cars can park and unload at once. Thank you for your support.
